What is in it for YOU?

- First and most importantly, if you skate and wish to compete **YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF A FIGURE CLUB** to do free skating competitions at Preliminary standard and above.

- Reduced entry fee to OFSC competitions
- Fun and friendship as a Club member participating in Club Events such as shows and parties.

ICE ETIQUETTE AND RULES

Basic rules must be observed for safety and to ensure that everyone can make effective use of their ice time during the figure sessions. Be sure to know and follow them at all times.

COURTESY – Respect the rights of other skaters and be constantly aware of who is around you.

PRIORITY – Skaters who have their music on have first priority. Then skaters who are in a lesson have second priority. Other skaters are expected to give way to these skaters who have priority.

JUMP END – The top end (the restaurant) is the area where most jumps take place. So it should be kept clear as much as possible. Don't stand around at this end. Use the end and move on as quickly as possible.

PREDICTABILITY – Try not to skate or behave in a way that would surprise other skaters. A practice session has a certain rhythm to it. People tend to do pretty "expectable" or "predictable" things and you can usually guess where somebody else is going, based on what they are doing when you see them (approaching a jump, spin, etc). Be aware that some skaters jump and spin in the opposite direction, so try to recognise them and adjust accordingly.

LOOK – If you are at the barrier, look to see where other skaters are moving before stepping out into paths of other skaters. Take note of where other skaters are around you. Skate with your eyes open!

DON'T STAND AROUND – Refrain from standing around and talking on the ice. This wastes expensive ice and presents additional hazards for other skaters.

FALLS – If you fall, get up quickly. Skaters have a hard time seeing you when you are lying on the ice.

DANGEROUS MOVES – If you are practicing elements like camel spins and back spirals be especially aware of the danger your exposed blade poses to other skaters. Once you have started the element it will be hard to see skaters. Take a good look at your expected "space" before you start the element and abort if it looks like you could cause a problem.
